## Schlesinger wins song-of-the-year

Fiddler and vocalist Paul Schlesinger of Taylor is the winner of the 2016 Western Swing Song of the Year for the tune, "You Were Meant to Ruin My Dreams.'

The song is a track on his CD, Paul Schlesinger and his Knights of Texas Swing. The presentation took place during the 21st annual Will Rogers Academy of Western Artists awards banquet in Fort Worth.

Schlesinger's CD, released last February, got its start in Rockdale back in 2006 when the initial recordings were made at Rockdale Sound, a studio operated by Scott Fischer.

You Were Meant to Ruin My Dreams" was written in 1949 by lyricist Cecil R. "Butterball" Harris and composer Arlie A. Carter, who were band members of Jimmy Heap and the Melody Masters from Taylor.

In January, Schlesinger was contacted by the Academy of Western Artists (AWA) and informed that his recording of the song was a Top 5 Finalist for Western Swing Song of Year. "I didn't know anything about the AWA and really had no idea the song would ultimately win," says Schlesinger. My wife Tara and I attended the event thinking it would just be an interesting expe-

rience, and we'd never have the opportunity to go again. However, I think she secretly had more faith than me!"

The Schlesingers are members of the Milam County Cowboy Church band, typically performing every second and fourth Sundays with the group.

They also perform for several area events, including the annual Milano VFD chili supper.

He is the music team leader for the Lee Countv Cowbov Church, and a member of that church's

band, Second Chance. Both Schlesinger and his

wife were named Entertainers of the Year in December 2016 by the Country Music Hall of Fame in Gatesville.

Dessens, who became a high-profile western swing musician, spent his formative years in Rockdale before settling in Houston.

Dowdy, who lived in Lexington, was a master rhythm guitarist and developed the western swing
